There are a lot of exciting things happening at Nazareth Presbyterian Church so be sure to read all about it in this issue of Nazareth News.

May 15th we will celebrate Pentecost. Pentecost was a prominent feast in the calendar of ancient Israel, celebrating the giving of the Law to Moses at Sinai. On the first Pentecost after Jesus' resurrection and ascension, God sent the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles and other followers of Jesus, just as he had promised. (**"I will not leave you orphaned . . . the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you everything and remind you of all that I have said to you . . ." John 15: 18, 25, 26**) Today, Pentecost is often described as the "birthday of the Church". I invite you all to worship with us and **wear red** to signify the coming and presence of the Holy Spirit.

During Worship on May 22, we will recognize many in our congregation who are our behind the scenes helpers. If you know someone who should be included, please let me know.
