Dear Nazareth friends.

It is hard to believe that we will begin the season of Lent in just a few days. Yes, Easter is early this year! I love the season of Lent – so much more than the season of Advent, perhaps because it is devoid of all the commercialism that accompanies Christmas.

The forty days of Lent begin Ash Wednesday and end at dusk the Saturday before Easter, not counting the Sundays in between. The Sundays during Lent, like every Sunday, are considered weekly celebrations of the resurrection. Lent is meant to be a time of self-reflection and penitence. In the wilderness between the Transfiguration and Calvary, Jesus had to decide if he would pray, "My will be done" or "Thy will be done". Lent is a good time for us to do the same.

Many denominations encourage disciples to renew and strengthen their faith during Lent by giving something up. Presbyterians do not. I try to observe a Holy Lent by *adding* something each year – reading through a specific book of the Bible, adding an act of service. For the past few years, I have had a Lenten prayer bag with the names of 40 people I love in it. Each morning I draw one name out and pray, very intentionally for that person throughout the day.

Another way to observe Lent is to attend the special events here at Nazareth. I find that the more I focus on the suffering of Christ on my behalf during Lent, the more joyous the Resurrection of Easter is for me. As has been the custom at Nazareth, there will be an Ash Wednesday Service in the Sanctuary on February 10th at 7:00. Please make plans to join us that evening. I will also be offering an Adult Lenten Bible Study on four Thursdays during Lent at 7:00. The classes will meet Feb 18th, 25th, March 3rd and March 10th.

Thanks to you all for making me feel so welcome here as we begin the Interim journey. This is a wonderful place to worship, fellowship and grow in Spirit and I look forward to our time together. My plan is to work Monday – Thursday from 9:00 to 5:00ish and take Friday as my Sabbath. My door is always open and I look forward to knowing each of your better. Blessings,
